Assists families and individuals based on income and assets to purchase food with an EBT (electronic benefits transfer) card.

Resource Limits

Families with a member age 60 or older or disabled: \$3,000

All other families: \$2,000

Applying for Food and Nutrition Services

An application must be completed to receive Food and Nutrition Services. You will need to provide items to prove you qualify for Food and Nutrition Services. If possible, bring in or send with your application. If you can't get all of these items, please apply anyway. You can provide information after you apply and the caseworker can help if you need assistance.

Eligibility Documents Required

(not all inclusive)

- Proof of State Residency
- Meet citizenship/Alienage and Identity Requirements
- Social Security Cards and birth certificates
- Proof of Income and expenses
- List of vehicles you or anyone in your household owns
- List of all property you or anyone in your household owns
