BEGINNING at a stake on the east side of Clay Street, formerly the northwest corner of Carden, thence in an easterly direction 130 feet, 10 inches to stake; thence in a northerly direction 62 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction 130 feet, 10 inches to a stake on the east side of Clay Street; thence with the east side of Clay Street in a southerly direction 62 feet to a stake, the point and place of BEGINNING, and being the "Dower Tract" allowed to the widow of L.A. Watts, as shown on a map in special proceeding file 603. This property was conveyed to Isabelle McDougle, Johnnie Mae Mangum, John Lee Smith, and Dwight D. Booze, as tenants in common, by deed recorded in Book 1603 at page 357, Durham County Registry. Isabelle McDougle died intestate May 27, 2002, survived only by brothers and sisters: Joe McMillian, Sophia McMillian, Daisy Malone (now deceased, survived by Lawrence Malon and James Weston), Bula Massey (now deceased, survived by Alice Fay (Harris), Nancy Lee, Linda Ray and Arthur Massey, Jr). Johnnie Mae Mangum, also known as Johnnie Mae Lofton, died June 23, 2005, survived by a spouse and five children: Johnny Lee Lofton, Angela Denise Strudwick, Frances Estelle Mangum, Otha Lee Mangum and Anthony Mangum). John Lee Smith died October 5, 1995, survived only by Johnnie Mae Mangum, so that his one-fourth undivided interest now is owned by the heirs of Johnnie Mae Mangum, referred to above. Dwight David Booze died February 14, 2004, survived only by a spouse, Cora Johnson-Booze.
